








Digital transformative pedagogy training (DTP)



Established partnerships with 4 universities in Kenya (Egerton, Umma, Pwani and Maasai Mara)

62 participants completed of the 87(43 UoN, and 19 from the partner universities)









Project deliverables

- Online Course Design: Four(4) quality online courses designed (Three (3) completed and One (1) in progress
- Assessment Rubrics: Two (2) assessment rubrics developed
- Best Practice on digital teaching and learning: six (6) cases documented
- Annual Project Report compiled
- Upscaling Plan of Training of Trainers (ToTs) developed

- 4. Updated ICT infrastructure enables effective implementation of DTP









LESSONS LEARNT

Challenges:

- 1. Some DTP training participants could not attend live interactive sessions fully due varying timetable of activities in their respective universities
- 2. Some Internet connectivity issues required some participants to upgrade their internet in order to attend to the training activities











Way Forward

- ☐ Upscale the project to involve more universities and participants.
- ☐ Carry out action research on DTP, at UoN and partner universities, to inform teaching and learning processes.
- ☐ Advanced skills training to include: Authoring Tools, Learning Design and Learning Analytics for online courses.
- ☐ Follow up on those trained on DTP for best practices and model case studies
